This is a Flexx child theme that has the full-width header image, as well as navigation areas above and below that full-width header.

This specific file is for the FlexxProfessional theme, but you can open the header.php file so that this full-width header child theme will work for any of the Flexx themes.

FlexxChild - Rotating Images Option

You will need to download the Flexx-specific option. Instead of using the Flexx header image, it will use the Rotating Images plugin. Example: (*the RI stands for Rotating Images*).

Flexx Additional Layout Options, select sections to include

Include the Navigation Above the Featured Images

Check this box if you wish to display the navigation bar above the header

Include the Featured (rotating) Images

Check this box if you wish to display the rotating Featured Images

Include the Navigation Below the Featured Images

Check this box if you wish to display the navigation bar below the header

Include the Feature Top widgets

Check this box if you wish to display the Featured Top widgets

Include the Sidebars

Check this box if you wish to display the left and/or right Sidebars

Include the Feature Bottom widgets

Check this box if you wish to display the Featured Bottom widgets

Include the Footer Credits

Check this box if you wish to display the Footer Credits

First - You need to modify the **style.css** file so that it works with your specific FlexxTheme.

Second - When creating a WordPress page, select **Configurable Landing Page** as the template. Then once you save the page you will see the settings box.

Setting the width of the site is technically done based on how you choose the Content layout section.

Narrow = 780px

Wide = 960px

Sidebars

Wide or Narrow layout of the site is determined by the layout you select via wp-dashboard > My Theme > Flexx Layout
